

DESTINY DAVIS, 20 **October 7, 2003 – Omaha, NE**

Destiny was gunned down by a spray of bullets that were fired from outside the living room window. Shantelle' ex-boyfriend, William C. Floyd, Jr., was aiming for Shantelle. Floyd and Shantelle had a history of a violent relationship. Destiny's mother, step-father, and 11-month old daughter were also in the home, but escaped injury. Her 7-year old nephew, however, was shot in the leg. Floyd fled jurisdiction, but he was located and convicted in 2005 of first-degree murder, manslaughter of an unborn child, and being a felon in possession of a weapon. In 2007, the state high court overturned Floyd's conviction due to improper communication between jurors and the bailiff. The Nebraska Supreme Court eventually upheld his convictions and sentences, ruling that the lower court did not communicate improperly. Floyd was sentenced to life in prison for murdering Destiny and 20 years for killing her unborn child.
